



Correlations to Florida Standards – Grades K and 1

Teachers: Below are ten Florida standards that correlate to topics explored in the book *St. Augustine A to Z*. They include standards from English Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, Health Education and Visual Art.

B – Basilica – **Identify** real and imaginary subject matter in works of art. (VA.K.F.1.2)

H – Horse and Carriage - **Recognize** items from the present and past, such as clothing and transportation. (SS.KA.2.In.a.)

L – Lighthouse – **Recognize** a water feature in a picture of a location. (SS.K.G.1.Su.d)

M – Menendez - **Identify** characters, settings, and major events in a story. (LAFS.K.RL.1.3)

O – Oldest School House – **Compare** life now with life in the past. (SS.1.A.2.2)

P – Ponce de Leon – **Recognize** a person who showed bravery. (SS.K.A.Su.d)

Q – Spanish Quarter – **Describe** the connection between two individuals, events, ideas, or pieces of information in a text. (LAFS.K.RI.1.3)

S – Sightseeing – **Recognize** that learning can come from careful observation. (SC.K.N.1.5)

U – Under the sun – **Identify** Healthy practices and behaviors to maintain or improve personal health. (HE.K.P. 7.1)

Z – Zoo - **Recognize** that some books and other media portray animals and plants with **characteristics and behaviors** they do not have in real life. (SC.K.L.14.2)
